- 3:00 3:15 Story, songs and home time.

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


The class have created their own 'Class Charter', where we have agreed our class expectations.

## **Behaviour: Traffic Light System**




Green – Expected Behaviour



- You have been given your log in to record your child's reading on Boom reader – we will also record any reading here too.

- Assessed on a regular basis




- Linked to projects
