

Year 1 - 2025

In Design Technology (D.T.):

Children will research sandwich fillings and the process needed to make a sandwich. They will make sandwiches, paying attention to hygiene and safety. Children will learn key skills such as cutting, grating and spreading which will then be used to make the final product. The children will then evaluate their sandwiches and give them a rating out of 5.

In English:

We will be writing accurate sentences that include capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and incorporate new vocabulary. We will learn the features of an instruction text:

1. 'How to' in the title
2. Time conjunctions
3. Numbered steps
4. Imperative verbs
5. Pictures

We will then have a go at writing our own instructions to make our own sandwich.

In Maths:

We will be continuing our work on using part whole models and addition number sentences. In the second part of the half term we will move on to solving subtraction problems.

Home Learning for 'Hill View Sandwich Bar'

Following a video of Paddington Bear serving the Queen marmalade sandwiches the children decided they could make even better sandwiches for their own bears. To get the best ideas they will look at and discuss a range of fillings, ask questions and use the ideas to create some healthy sandwiches. The children will research healthy food choices and learn about food hygiene. Each class will become a sandwich making team, who will take on different roles to produce the perfect healthy sandwich. The children will then taste their own sandwiches at a teddy bears picnic on **Tuesday 9th December** where the children can bring in their own bears (or cuddly toy).
