Once you have logged in and selected the appropriate child (if you have more than one at Hill View Primary), please scroll down to "Activities" and select "Trips". Select the trip you would like to pay for and follow the instructions to make payment.

By making payment for this trip, you are giving permission for your child to attend SeaCity Museum on Friday 16th January 2026. **Please note that this trip will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students.** Should you have any present financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially, and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements.

Children should arrive at school on the day at the normal time. The coaches will depart promptly at 09:00 and will return to school ready for normal pick-up time at 15:15.

Children should wear their normal school uniform. Please ensure your child has a named water bottle and a backpack for use throughout the day. Children will require a packed lunch. If you have ordered a hot school meal for Friday 16th January, this will automatically be converted to a packed lunch for the trip and will delivered to school and given to children in the morning.
