

Dear Year 4 parents and carers,

The week beginning 2<sup>nd</sup> June marks the start of our official window to complete the official Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) that I informed you about in Term 1. Our pupils have had regular practice towards this check and are familiar with how it runs and the timing that is given for each question. The progress we have seen has showcased the hard work that children are putting in to learning their multiplication facts and it has positively impacted their confidence and accuracy in Maths lessons and when they are needing to recall these key facts.

It would be beneficial for your child to ensure that they are maintaining their progress and scores through practicing during the half term. Below is a selection of useful websites and tools that you could access in this final stage before the MTC. If your child completed a minimum of 20 minutes per day, this will positively impact their confidence and accuracy when their official check comes around. Each child has been given an activity booklet which focuses on the times table facts that they have been working on and good practice would be to complete a page of these per day.
