

HOME LEARNING MENU

We have been learning about British Woodland and Wildlife. We would like you to go on some Welly Walks with your family and explore the woods! If you can get out each week that would be great as we will be setting different challenges.

- Go and explore your local woodland. Can you spot any signs of Autumn? Can you find any fallen objects that are autumnal? Using a strip of tape or sticky paper can you collect and stick different autumnal objects to it. Can you fill the strip?



- Can you collect different leaves from a variety of trees? Use some of these leaves to create some leaf rubbings.



- Look out for signs of animals in the woodland. How do you know animals may have been there? Can you find any footprints, nests, burrows or droppings? You may even find some nibbled pine cones or nuts! Draw pictures and label your findings
