In school we are going to be making clay animals to create our own Hill View Farm. The animals will need a home and therefore for home learning we are asking the children to create their own shoebox homes for the animals, please leave room for the clay animals in your box. (This is a great half term project!)

Each colour group will be creating a different farm animal and your shoebox home needs to be reflective of this.

Red - Pigs (Muddy Pig Sty)

Green - Chickens (Hen House)

Yellow - Sheep (Grassy Field)

Blue - Cow (Milking Shed)

Orange - Horse (Stable)
