

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to inform you of an upcoming trip for Year 3 to Corfe castle as part of our Dragon's and castles project.

Date of the Trip: Wednesday 1st October 2025.
Cost: £14.00 per child.
Payment required by: Friday 26th September 2025.

Payments for this should be made by using the **Arbor App**. Once you have logged in and selected the appropriate child (if you have more than one at Hill View Primary), please scroll down to "Activities" and select "Trips". Select the trip you would like to pay for and follow the instructions to make payment.

By making payment for this trip, you are giving permission for your child to attend Corfe Castle on Wednesday 1st October 2025. **Please note that this trip will not be able to go ahead without full payment from all students.** Should you have any present financial difficulty, please don't hesitate to contact the school office to discuss this confidentially and a payment plan can be organised to accommodate your requirements.

It is essential that children arrive promptly at school at 08:35 to ensure they have an opportunity to go to the toilet and to conduct a safety briefing. The coach will depart promptly at **09:00** and will return to school ready for normal pick-up time at 15:15.

Children should wear their PE Kit with trainers/ comfortable shoes. Please ensure your child has a named water bottle and a backpack for use throughout the day. We recommend packing a waterproof coat in case it rains. Children will require a packed lunch. If you have ordered a hot school meal for Wednesday 1st October, this will automatically be converted to a packed lunch for the trip and will delivered to school and given to children in the morning.

No spending money is required as children will not have time to visit the gift shop – we will be having too much fun learning!

If you are available to help out on this day and join us on the coach and at Corfe Castle, please speak to your child's class teacher or make contact with the school office.
