



Home Learning for the project: The Land of Fire and Ice

Home-learning challenge:

For your home-learning this term, your teachers would like you to design and make a model or an information leaflet about of a physical feature of Iceland. For example, a volcano, mountain, glacier or a river. These will be shared with the rest of the year group in our 'Land of Fire and Ice' finale.

For children wishing to make an interactive model, for example, a volcano which can erupt, we will be sharing this on the playground with the entire year group. If you wish for this to happen, please supply the materials for the eruption.

When creating your home learning, remember to:

- Use a range of research methods - books and computers.
- Present your work in a creative way.
- Find out information about the feature specific to Iceland e.g. not just volcanoes in general- what volcanoes are in Iceland and what is currently happening with them?

Ask an adult to:

- Help you find appropriate books in the library.
- Use effective research ideas when using the computer, for example when using 'Google' make sure you use key words.
- Ensure you ask an adult for help when you cut and create things.
- Ensure you are with an adult when using any specific resources for making experiments e.g. if
