Thursday 13th November	 <p>The children come in their uniform but can also wear a hat, cape, or badge to represent their 'inner hero'. We'll be talking about real-life heroes who use their power for good every day.</p>
Friday 14th November CHILDREN IN NEED	 <p>The children come dressed in spots for this year's Children in Need theme Spotacular. During the day, each class will also take part in our Dance-a-thon to raise money for Children in Need. Donations of £1 will go to Children in Need.</p>

Please note: The only non-uniform day is **Friday 14th November**.

All other days, children should wear their usual uniform with the themed item.
